ALPHA ONLINE




HOME GROUPS



I have read and would recommend 'Listening to God' by Joyce Huggett which I expect many have read but it is a good one to re-visit and 'The Art of Prayer' by Timothy Jones.



I have also read 'Storylines' and 'Lifelines' both of which are by Andy Croft & Mike Pilavachi.

Storylines looks at 6 overarching themes in the Bible - Jesus, Covenant, Presence, Kingdom, Salvation and Worship - each revealing a way of understanding Scripture that makes it live and breathe, relevant to life today.

Lifelines is a walk with 8 biblical characters and what we can learn from their success, struggles and failures
